## <u>Subject: Streamlined Registration process on the NHRA-MVC Traceability Hub Portal</u> <u>for Pharmaceutical Product Traceability</u>

As per Resolution No. 41 of the year 2017, and in accordance with the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) Medicines Barcoding and Serialization Guideline; Kingdom of Bahrain; May 2019 Version 1.2, The Bahrain National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) has contracted with MVC W.L.L to establish and manage the "NHRA-MVC" Traceability Hub track and trace system for the Kingdom of Bahrain as per Circular (46) 2020, 11th November 2020.

All pharmacies, government pharmacies, hospitals, and points of the dispensation of medicines are being granted a short extension of time to register with the NHRA-MVC.

- 1. The NHRA-MVC has extended the registration deadline through **15 November, 2021** to accommodate all remaining pharmacies, government pharmacies, hospitals, and other points of dispensation of medicines that have not registered.
  - NHRA-MVC has streamlined the registration process for those who are unregistered.
