**Subject: Compliance with Use of the NHRA-MVC Traceability Hub for Pharmaceutical Product Traceability**

Dear All,


As per Resolution No. 41 of the year 2017, and in reference to Circular No. (17) 2022 Use of the NHRA-MVC Traceability Hub for Pharmaceutical Product Traceability, all pharmaceuticals entering the Kingdom of Bahrain are subject to serialization in accordance with the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) Medicines Barcoding and Serialization Guideline; Kingdom of Bahrain; May 2019 Version 1.2.

As per Circular No. (30) 2022 Use of the NHRA-MVC Traceability Hub for Pharmaceutical Product Traceability, the deadline of **31<sup>st</sup> December 2022** for All Agents/Distributors (Importers) in the Kingdom of Bahrain and All Invoicing Companies (MAHs, Manufacturers, Exporting Distributors) to ensure that scanning activities has now passed.

Any Agents/Distributors (Importers) in the Kingdom of Bahrain and All Invoicing Companies (MAHs, Manufacturers, Exporting Distributors) who are not currently in compliance with Resolution No.41 must contact the NHRA-MVC Support Team at [NHRA-MVC-support@rfxcel.com](mailto:NHRA-MVC-support@rfxcel.com) or through our webpage [Contact Us – NHRA-MVC](#) to remedy this situation immediately.
