Reason of Recall	<p>NHRA initiates this FSN due to the risks associated with the use of the above-mentioned hand sanitizing gel as it contains high percentage of <b>Benzalkonium Chloride</b> which can cause the following side effects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Swelling.</li> <li>• Redness.</li> <li>• Very bad skin irritation.</li> </ul> <p>And based on Ministry of health test report, it showed that Ethyl alcohol and Isopropyl alcohol content is less than the approved percentage 70% which reduces the effectiveness if the product.</p>
