The below medical devices are prohibited to be imported to Kingdom of Bahrain due to the risks associated with use of them to protect patients and public health.

Tattoo Ink	Refer to Circular No. (8) 2019

Stem Cells	Restricted for approved clinical researches by NHRA and for orthopedic procedures.
Air Doctor Disinfectant	Medical Claim of this product is not accurate and not scientifically proven. Refer to Circular No. (6) 2020
