Mobile medical clinics

I. Conditions for the provision of mobile clinic services:

1. Determine working days and hours.
2. The mobile clinic cannot operate until the application has been submitted and granted the final approval from NHRA.
3. In the absence of a laboratory within the facility, a contract is required with any external laboratory licensed by NHRA .
4. Getting a consent from the patients for their approval to the treatment.
5. Determine the scope of services provided and licensed by NHRA.

II. Policies required

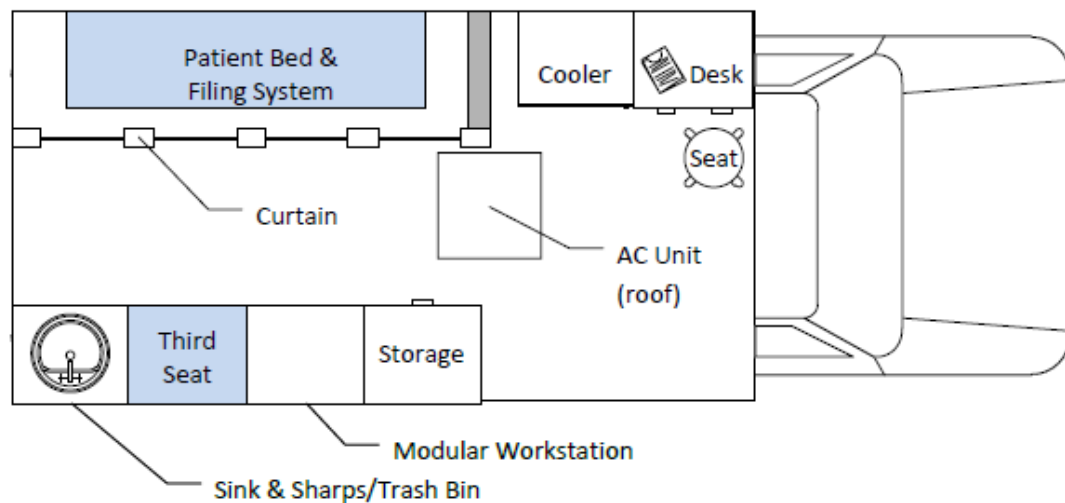
1. Management of Medical Information and Records
2. Medical waste management and infection control
3. Booking appointment
4. Sterilization when needed
5. Blood samples storage and transfer
6. Drug Storage and protection and safety of medicines
7. A clear policy for dealing with emergencies once happened

III. Engineering requirements for mobile clinics :

The mobile clinic must be equipped with the following:

1. Medical supplies storage area
2. Medicine cabinet .
3. Provision of a refrigerator to maintain the safety of medicines if needed.

4. Generator and fire extinguishers
5. Air conditioning unit, indoor lighting system and external lights to illuminate the place surrounding the clinic
6. Source of fresh water and laundry, which the water source should be away from the generator
7. Medical bed or chair depending on the activity that will be provided
8. The name of the facility should be visible from outside the clinic with a copy of the license hanged inside the clinic.
9. Taking into consideration the special needs, a mobile slope should be available to be used if needed.
10. Provision of medical waste container.



V. Engineering requirements in the office

1. Allocate places for:
 - a. Sterilization if needed.
 - b. Medical waste if needed.
 - c. To keep medical records.
 - d. To save medical supplies.
 - e. An administrative office and control room to receive calls.
2. Provide a refrigerator to maintain medicine safety.

VI. Medical staff:

1. A minimum of one physician, a nurse and a driver must be available according to the health service provided.
2. In case of blood collection service being provided, a licensed technician must be available.
