Subject: Notice of Termination of Current NHRA-MVC Traceability Hub Provider

In accordance with Resolution No. 41 of the year 2017, and the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) Medicines Barcoding and Serialization Guideline, Kingdom of Bahrain, please be informed that the existing Memorandum of Understanding with MVC W.L.L. for managing the NHRA-MVC Traceability Hub will terminate effective 11th August 2026.

Please note the following:

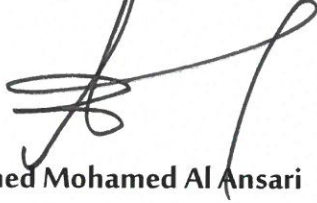
1. Fee collection for the regulatory reporting period commencing August 2026 will be instructed separately by NHRA. Effective immediately, no further fee payments for future terms after July 2026 should be made to MVC W.L.L.
2. All Invoicing Companies, Agents/Distributors, and Dispensers are instructed to continue their current reporting obligations through the existing NHRA-MVC Traceability Hub without change until further notification.
3. Participants who have not yet completed contractual and/or technical onboarding are requested to immediately halt onboarding activities and notify NHRA exclusively.

All communications, inquiries, or notifications related to this circular must be directed exclusively to the provided NHRA email address **track-and-trace@nhra.bh**. Communications sent to any other addresses will not be acknowledged or responded to.

NHRA will provide timely and clear instructions to ensure an uninterrupted flow of data in accordance with the effective mandate, avoiding disruptions in ongoing supply-chain operations.
