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# GAP OF PRACTICE

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2022



A gap of practice is defined as a period of discontinuation of licensed clinical experience/practice.

**This guide applies to Bahrainis and Non-Bahrainis with family residence permits in Bahrain ONLY**

If an applicant fails to prove the continuity of his/her clinical practice for a period as specified in the relevant PQR, the applicant will be required to provide the following:

1. To pass examination as per NHRA regulation.
2. If the applicant didn't pass the exam he should provide:
  - a. Evidence of 100 CPD hours as per relevant PQR noting that all CME/CPD credits must be related to practice specialty of the healthcare professional, and according to the CME/CPD specific requirements of NHRA.
  - b. All applicants are required to go through a 6 months of clinical training which should be carried out in an approved practice setting by the NHRA and provide evidence of completion of this training.
  - c. All applicants after completion of CME/CPD credits and clinical training,  
After completion of all the requirements, the application will be approved, and the process of new license application will be followed.
