All fees shown in the above table are annual, except for the visiting doctor's license fee, which is for one month only, and a fraction of a month is calculated as a full month.	
- The license renewal application must be submitted at least one month before the expiry of its validity period, and the fee will be doubled if the application is submitted within the two months following the expiration of the license period.	
- In the event that the license application is submitted after two months from the expiry date of its term, it is considered a new license, and in this case the first license fee is doubled.
