**To: All unregistered pharmacies, government pharmacies, and hospitals; all points of the dispensation of medicines in the Kingdom of Bahrain.**

**Subject: Streamlined Registration process on the NHRA-MVC Traceability Hub Portal for Pharmaceutical Product Traceability**

As per Resolution No. 41 of the year 2017, and in accordance with the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) Medicines Barcoding and Serialization Guideline; Kingdom of Bahrain; May 2019 Version 1.2, The Bahrain National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) has contracted with MVC W.L.L to establish and manage the "NHRA-MVC" Traceability Hub track and trace system for the Kingdom of Bahrain as per Circular (46) 2020, 11th November 2020.

**All pharmacies, government pharmacies, hospitals, and points of the dispensation of medicines are being granted a short extension of time to register with the NHRA-MVC.**

1. The NHRA-MVC has extended the registration deadline through **15 November, 2021** to accommodate all remaining pharmacies, government pharmacies, hospitals, and other points of dispensation of medicines that have not registered.
  - NHRA-MVC has streamlined the registration process for those who are unregistered. You must go to the NHRA-MVC website [www.nhra-mvc.bh](http://www.nhra-mvc.bh) and complete your sign-up process as soon as possible.
